Please could you confirm whether people working outside of HEE are able to submit nominations for the HEAT awards?

The 2020 HEAT Awards are open to anyone who is delivering a service to the NHS in England or who is studying to work in the NHS.

Is possible to be nominated for both an individual award e.g. Trainee as well as a team award e.g. 21st-century healthcare for the upcoming HEAT 2020 nominations?

There is no restriction to the number of awards an individual or team can be nominated for.

Is there a cost to submit a nomination?

No.

Can I submit additional material to support my nomination, like pictures and video footage?

It is not possible to include additional material or links to additional material.

Why do you ask for so many details from us?

We seek to ask the minimum number of questions to enable us to deliver the awards. We ask for contact details for the nominator in case we have any queries about the awards and ask for contact details for the nominee to enable us to contact them.

How much are tickets to the award ceremony?

Tickets are free but are limited one for each finalist who will be able to invite one guest plus a further ticket for the nominator. Teams will be able to send two representatives plus the nominator.

Are nominations anonymous?

If nominee asks who nominates them then we will inform them and the nominator will also be invited along with the nominee to the awards ceremony.

Can you vote for a team you work in?

There are no votes but can submit a nomination for your team. You cannot, however, submit a nomination for yourself for an individual award.
