Health Economist Update

The work on the definition of the value proposition is now completed. In summary, compared to usual practice, the EST is expected to generate value:

- For the health and care system, by providing: a cost-effective alternative to "usual practice" staffing models, improved system efficiency and improved workforce longevity and productivity.
- For surgeons in training, enabling more time to focus on activities which promote training and learning.
- For EST advanced care practitioners (ACPs), providing opportunities for clinical career progression and skills enhancement.

The EST is expected to support the delivery of services which are at least as safe and effective as the traditional workforce model, and have the potential to reduce clinical risks compared with "usual practice". We will be including a more detailed summary of the work in our interim report, potentially including selected case studies from the pilots to show achieved/potential economic value from an EST approach and the timescales over which benefits are likely to be realised.

We will also be providing some useful resources for NHS Trusts to help inform local decisions to start, or continue, to invest in an EST supported surgical pathway.
