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Welcome to the CapitalMidwife Skills Passport.

CapitalMidwife is committed to ensuring that every midwife in London is valued, respected, listened to and supported to reach their full potential.

This document is one of several resources developed by midwives through CapitalMidwife for you, to ensure you are provided with support and guidance throughout your career.

What is it?

The CapitalMidwife Skills Passport provides a handheld, easily accessible personal record providing confirmation of all the post registration training received on a common set of core clinical skills required of every midwife.

The passport does not include a record of clinical and medical devices training, and other training that is local to specific trusts and is within their responsibilities to provide guidance on.

Who is it for?

It is a tool for all midwives to record clinical skills that have been achieved.

Why is it needed?

It was developed to reduce the burden placed on midwives from having to repeat training when moving from one London trust to another.

The Skills Passport is currently presented in a paper version, but is underpinned with a long term vision to become a digital record.



Core Clinical Skills Identified

Annually taught/trained

- 1. Adult resuscitation
- 2. Neonatal resuscitation
- 3. Sepsis
- 4. Antepartum haemorrhage (APH)
- 5. Postpartum haemorrhage (PPH)
- 6. Eclampsia
- 7. Shoulder dystocia
- 8. Breech birth
- 9. Cord prolapse
- 10. Intrapartum fetal monitoring (competency tested)

Competency achieved

- 1. IV administration (incl. blood products)
- 2. IV cannulation
- 3. Perineal suturing

How were these skills prioritised for inclusion?

The identified skills were selected based on an assessment of the most commonly occurring mandatory clinical skills required across London Trusts, reviewed against the requirements stipulated in CNST Safety Action #8, CQC guidance and the Saving Babies Lives Care Bundle.

The identified skills will be reviewed in future versions of the Skills Passport, with the view to include additional skills as they become standardised.
