Submit your expression of interest to participate in an exciting health system strengthening pilot project in Gulu. The project will support the development of diagnostic imaging services by utilising the skills of long-term, short-term and virtual volunteers.

This offer is open to any of the multi-disciplinary team, including radiographers, radiologists, sonographers, imaging educators, business managers and equipment engineers within the English NHS.

The pilot will evaluate whether this model of volunteering can demonstrate a mutual benefit to both the hospital service and to the volunteers.

Participants in similar projects report that in addition to having made a major contribution to health care in a resources-limited setting, they have also developed their leadership, decision making, clinical skills and resilience.

We are working towards a start date in autumn 2021/ early 2022.
