London GP Specialty Trainee 3 and 4 Career Intentions survey now live Please complete the London GP Specialty Trainee 3 and 4 Career Intentions 2023 <u>survey</u> by 28 June.

The survey is open to all GP specialty trainees due to qualify and gain their Certificate of Completion of Training during summer 2023 and seeks to find out more about their intentions on completing training now, and also over the next 2-5 years.

Previous survey findings have been shared with service commissioners, educators and training hubs to inform:

- future workforce development opportunities for newly-qualified GPs
- the development of recruitment and retention initiatives that address the factors that influence career choice.
