#### **Core Offer NHS (for the Health & Care Sector)**

The Pledge aims to put employers at the heart of inspiring the next generation of young people in Cheshire and Warrington. Some of our employer partners were impressed enough to fully fund a Pledge team member to promote and excite young people to join a specific sector, in this case the Health & Care sector.

The general consensus amongst both the Adult Social Care providers and the NHS in the local area is poor in relation to current recruitment and retention trends. Waiting lists for homecare are becoming common. Such delays are causing delayed hospital discharges and increasing the risk of hospital admissions/readmissions – putting pressure on an already overstretched NHS. Some areas have seen homecare agencies handing back commissioned packages of care due to the lack of staff. There is an increased concern at the reliability and quality of homecare alongside this.

Furthermore, some of the demographic statistics for the field are shocking - indicating that the average age of an employee within Adult Social Care is 44 and less than 5% of the employees in the NHS are under 25. This starkly demonstrates that the need to partner with an organisation with a real impact on young people is crucial.

Whether you are an organisation affiliated with the NHS or work with them to achieve their shared goal within the Cheshire & Mersey Health & Care Partnership, we need your support.



- Attend our Annual Conference to network, learn and sign up for careers events.





Activity	Summary
September - December	
Multi-school local Pledge Careers and Post 16 Fair – Targeted at Y10 / Y12	Have a stand for your company at a careers fair for multiple schools within your locality. This will help raise your profile and potentially develop a pipeline. Or there will be possibilities to take a young person on for work experience / volunteering opportunities.
Pledge Explore Programme – Y10	Host a short site visit at your company for a targeted group of 15 vulnerable students from a school to help them to explore opportunities and raise aspirations.
Employment Readiness Programme – Y13	Help year 13 students who are actively seeking apprenticeships or jobs to be more employment ready. Specific to the Health & Care sector – emphasising on the Values based recruitment methods, interview preparation and experience, the application process all supported through co-delivery sessions.
January - April	
Apprenticeship and Jobs fair Y11 – Y13	Host a stand at our sub regional apprenticeships and jobs fair to help recruit young staff.
Spring into Careers virtual – live Y7-Y9	Submit a 3 minute video to be part of an online event to help build awareness of your business or the Health & Care sector to younger students.
May - July	
Virtual Work Experience – Y10 / Y12	Take part in our minimal resource work experience, delivery virtually or as a hybrid with 3 employer touch points throughout a week. This will help to build visibility and a talent pipeline.
