	<p><u>Minimum entry requirements for enrolment for the 4year pathway</u> Individual employer partners may identify their own requirements in terms of previous qualifications, training or other criteria. All candidates must however have GCSE Maths and English (grade C or above) or a recognized equivalent qualification such as Level 2 Functional Skills. DBS checks are also a requirement for all applicants.</p> <p><u>Minimum entry requirements for enrolment for the 2year APEL pathway</u> Applicants must have achieved 120 credits at Level 4 in a relevant associated programme. Evidence of 675 hours of clinical practise (aligned to NMC essential skills cluster for the first progression point) must also be evidenced. GCSE Maths and English (grade C or above) or a recognized equivalent qualification such as Level 2 Functional Skills. Guidance and support would be provided by Bucks New University before and throughout this process.</p> <p><u>Models of delivery</u> The Registered Nurse Degree Apprenticeship programme is delivered through theoretical block release, clinical placement blocks and blocks of time spent in the host ward. There are a minimal number of day schools, where the cohort come together, as our delivery brings the equivalent of lectures and tutorials to students through synchronous and asynchronous tutor supported activities that students can access and revisit. Students receive support in practice from a Practice Tutor (both face to face and online) and online support from a module tutor.
