The on-site clinic

- Private clinic
- Independent of external governance (except HCPC)
- Control over patient flow
- On campus



Facts and figures

- 2,700 registered patients
- 3,400 treatments per year
- 500 to 600 new patients annually
- Offer a range of podiatric services
- Clinic is utilised for inter-professional teaching and learning with physiotherapy and pharmacy students.



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Why the clinic is in place

- The foundation of workforce development
- Experiential learning throughout the degree is essential
- Seamless blend of theory and practice

Advantages/benefits

- 1-2-1 with students putting theory into practice
- Teaching that gold standard level of care – creating that firm foundation for workforce development
- Effective communication/engagement promoting PCC
- Group work – introducing collaboration at an early stage
- Breaking down barriers – crossing services/depts



- Constant flow of patients when/if required for extra teaching purposes
