

Workforce Streamlining –One year on Event

Evaluation

Did the event meet your expectations?

The majority of attendees felt the event met or exceeded their expectations and the time for presentations, networking etc. was sufficient.

The feedback indicates that attendees felt it was useful to review the progress to date including barriers as well as share as information between the regions. Some felt the sessions were a little repetitive and would have benefited from more detail on how some of the challenges had been overcome.

How satisfied were you with the facilities at Haydock Park?

The majority of attendees were very satisfied with the facilities, although a few commented on the Lancaster Suite being a little cold.

How useful did you find the afternoon workshop?

The majority of attendees found the workshops to be very useful or extremely useful. Most attendees did not state which workshop they attended, so determining the response for each one is limited.

Is there any support that you/your team/your Trust, do not already receive from the Streamlining Team

Responses indicated a general sense of good support already being provided, although many requested more information sharing across the three STP areas. Some asked for a regional workstream meetings, others hope to benefit from the work taking place elsewhere in the region.

Is there anything you would like to see at the next event?

Responses included more time to network, an opportunity for attendees to raise questions in advance that could be addressed on the day and more opportunities to work at workstream level.

Additional Comments

There were many positive responses saying it was an excellent and well organised event. A couple felt that negativity in one of the workstreams, recruitment, held back discussion and that the group should be willing to share more. Other attendees felt it may be better to ascertain what the workstreams would want from a workshop to better make use of the time.
