We currently have opportunities for previously registered midwives who would like to undertake their clinical placements at (Insert Trust/Location).

The Return to Practice course starts in September 2021 at Kingston and St Georges or January 2022 at University of Greenwich, both of which consists of a theoretical component which is delivered by the University.

The practical component of the programme includes working and learning in clinical practice areas to support your learning and achieve the required clinical competencies. The amount of time in practice will vary depending on how long you have been out of practice and whether you choose to work the practice hours part or full time.

The Return to Practice programme is funded by Health Education England, and successful applicants will receive a bursary payment of £650 to support study costs.

On successful completion of the programme you will regain your NMC registration and you may be able to get a permanent position within our Trust as a Band 5 Registered Midwife.
