Tier 3

Health, social care and other professionals with a high degree of autonomy, able to provide care in complex situations and/or may also lead services for people with a learning disability.

Tier 2

Health and social care staff and others with responsibility for providing care and support for a person or people with a learning disability, but who would seek support from others for complex management or complex decision-making.

Tier 1

Those that require general awareness of people with a learning disability and the support they need.
